### Calculators

It is important that your child has a calculator in school. They are not just used in maths lessons – for example, science lessons are often planned for students assuming that they have a calculator with them.

In maths at GCSE, two of the three papers allow the use of a calculator, therefore it makes sense to get used to how it works and all the extra things you can do with it.

Like most schools we recommend the latest Casio model – FX-83GTX – always better than the last! – shown below. Other calculators are acceptable but are not as good.

We sell them at school at cost, currently £10.75 and they may be ordered online through your scopay account. You will see them on sale in supermarkets for as much as £25...

If you are thinking of A-Level and perhaps looking further ahead and considering a graphical calculator you may look at what is available from Casio here and whether it is ok for GCSE.





The EduLink App provides a convenient and accessible way for us to communicate with parents on some of the main aspects of daily school life.


It's easy to use and is accessible from a smart phone, tablet or PC. You can use the app to report an absence easily and also book appointments for your child's Parents' Evening.




