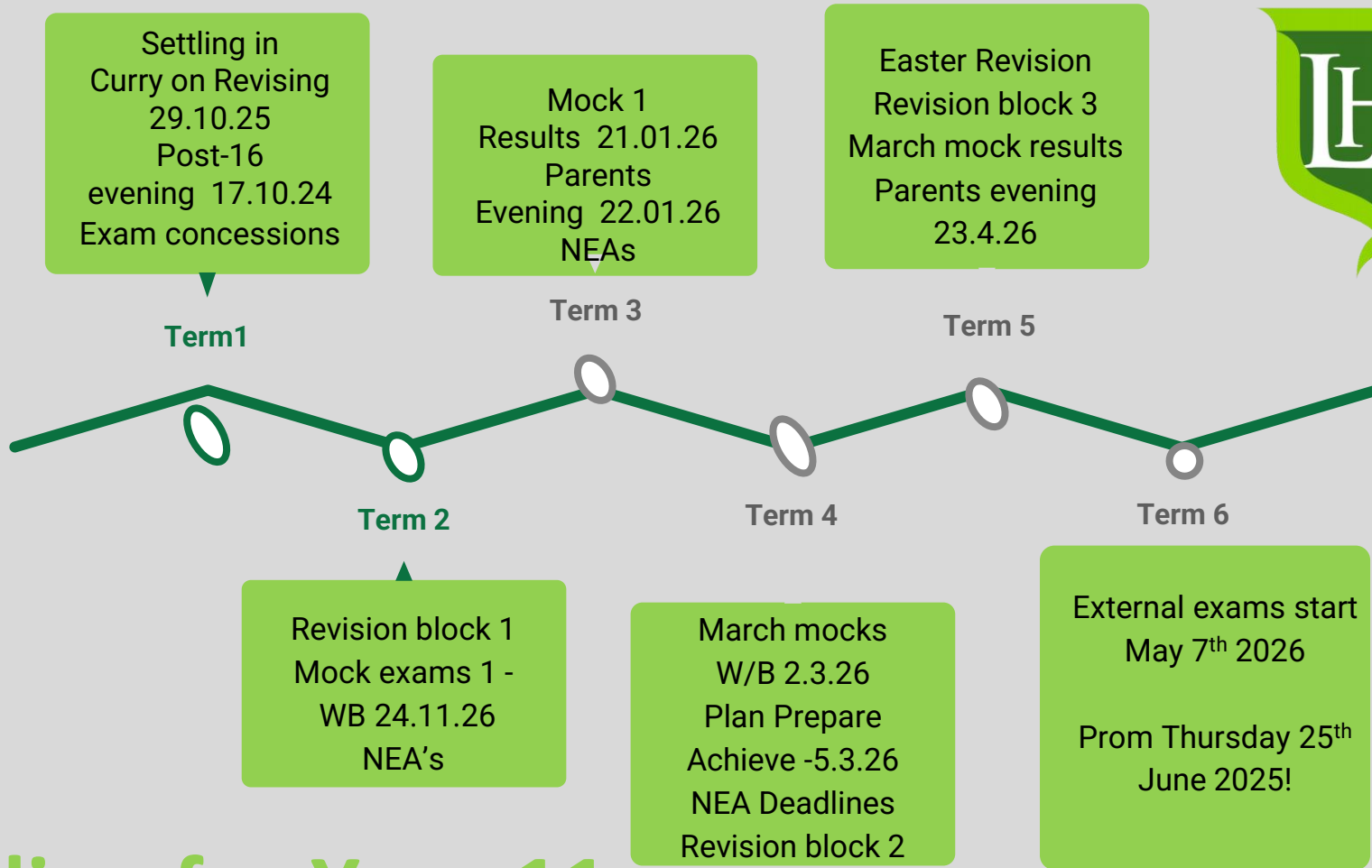

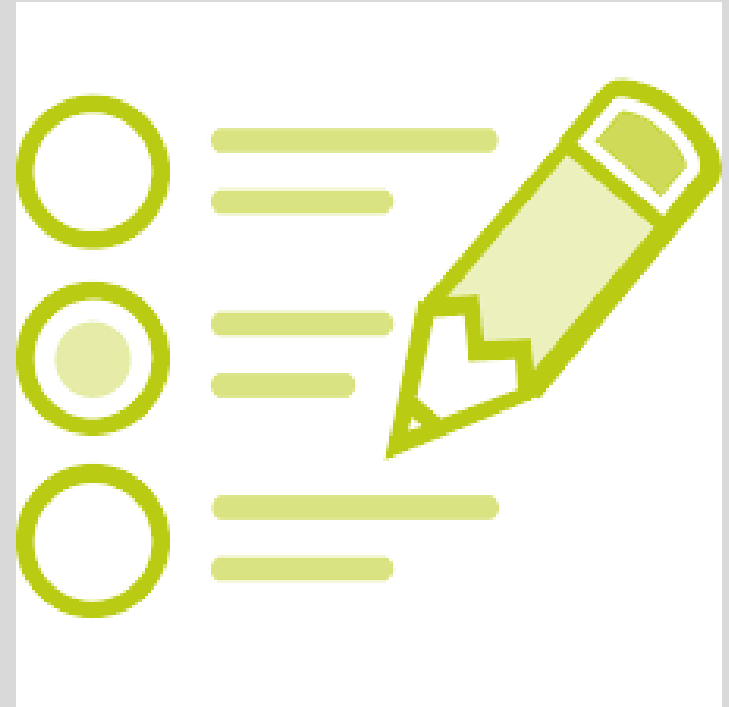
Approaching assessments

- In March, you will be asked to check and confirm the entries we have made for the final exams in the summer are accurate
- Mocks – no more than 2 exams per day
- Summer exams – follow the national timetable

- A clear water bottle if you wish to take one in – it is important it does not have a label on

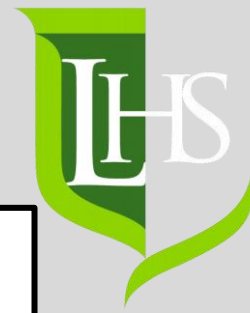


What you cannot take into the exam:

Target Grades



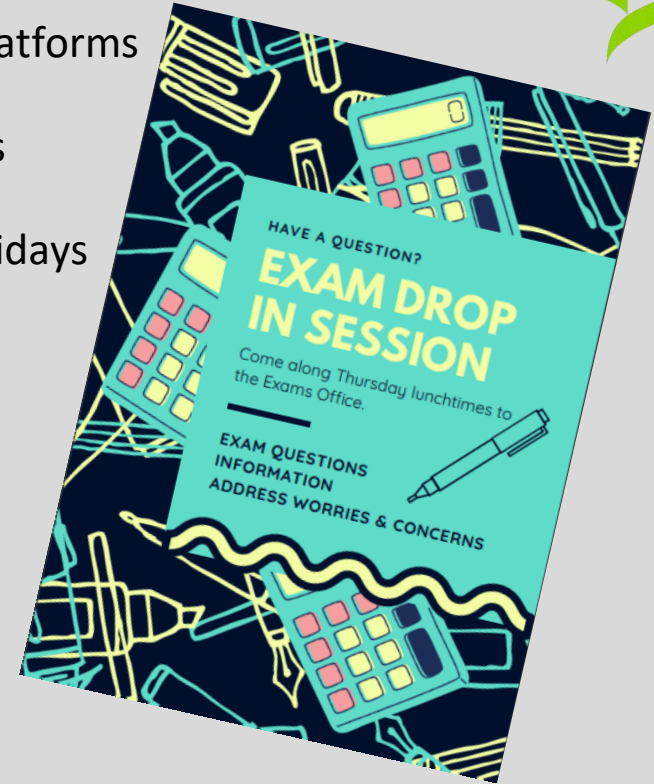
- Year 11 'Target Grades' are being reviewed by your teachers.

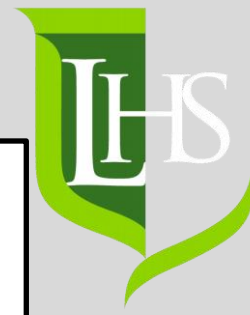
Exam stress symptoms

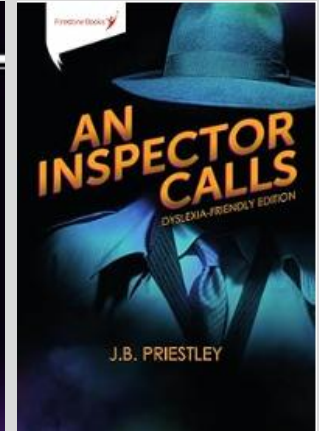
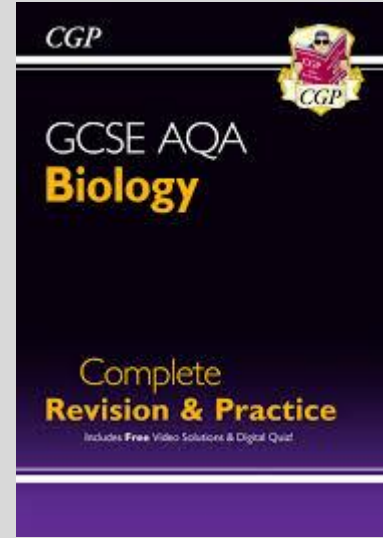
Homework

Part-time Employment

Term time rules

During term time children can only work a maximum of 12 hours a week. This includes:

- a maximum of 2 hours on school days and Sundays
- a maximum of 5 hours on Saturdays for 13 to 14-year-olds, or 8 hours for 15 to 16-year-olds

School holiday rules

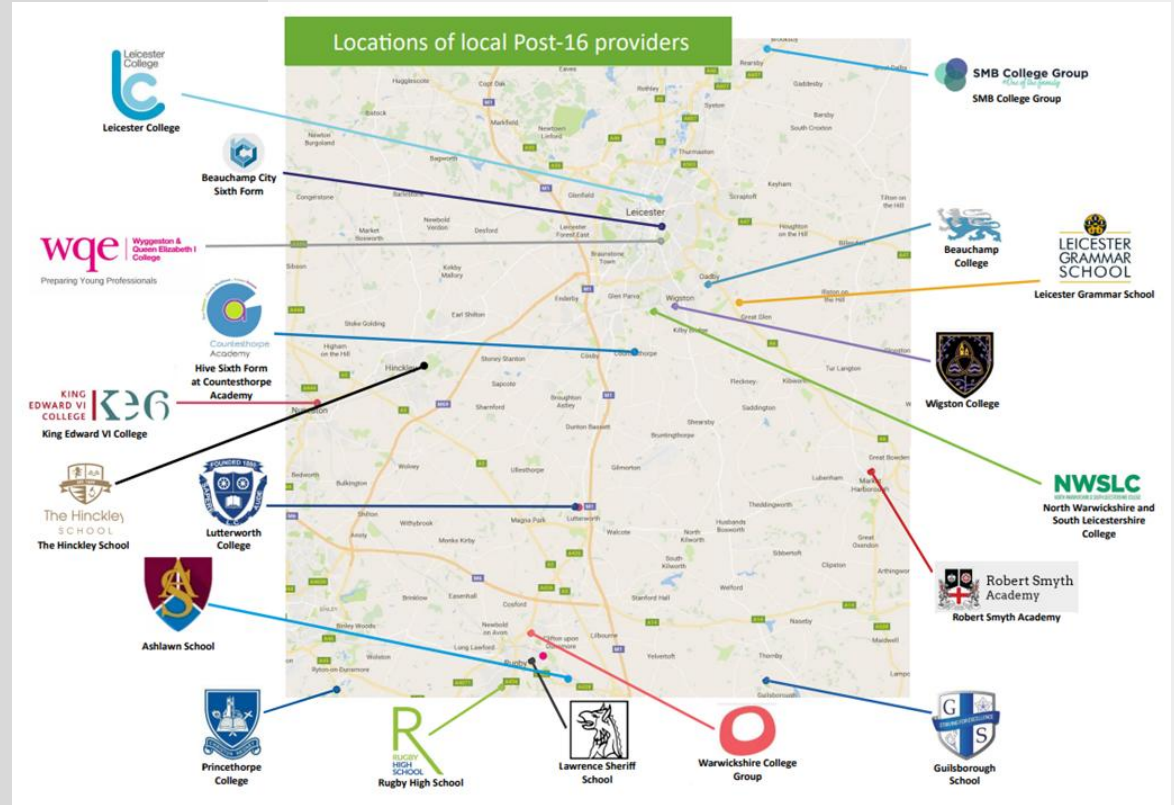
During school holidays 13 to 14-year-olds are only allowed to work a maximum of 25 hours a week. This includes:

- a maximum of 5 hours on weekdays and Saturdays
- a maximum of 2 hours on Sunday

During school holidays 15 to 16-year-olds can only work a maximum of 35 hours a week. This includes:

- a maximum of 8 hours on weekdays and Saturdays
- a maximum of 2 hours on Sunday

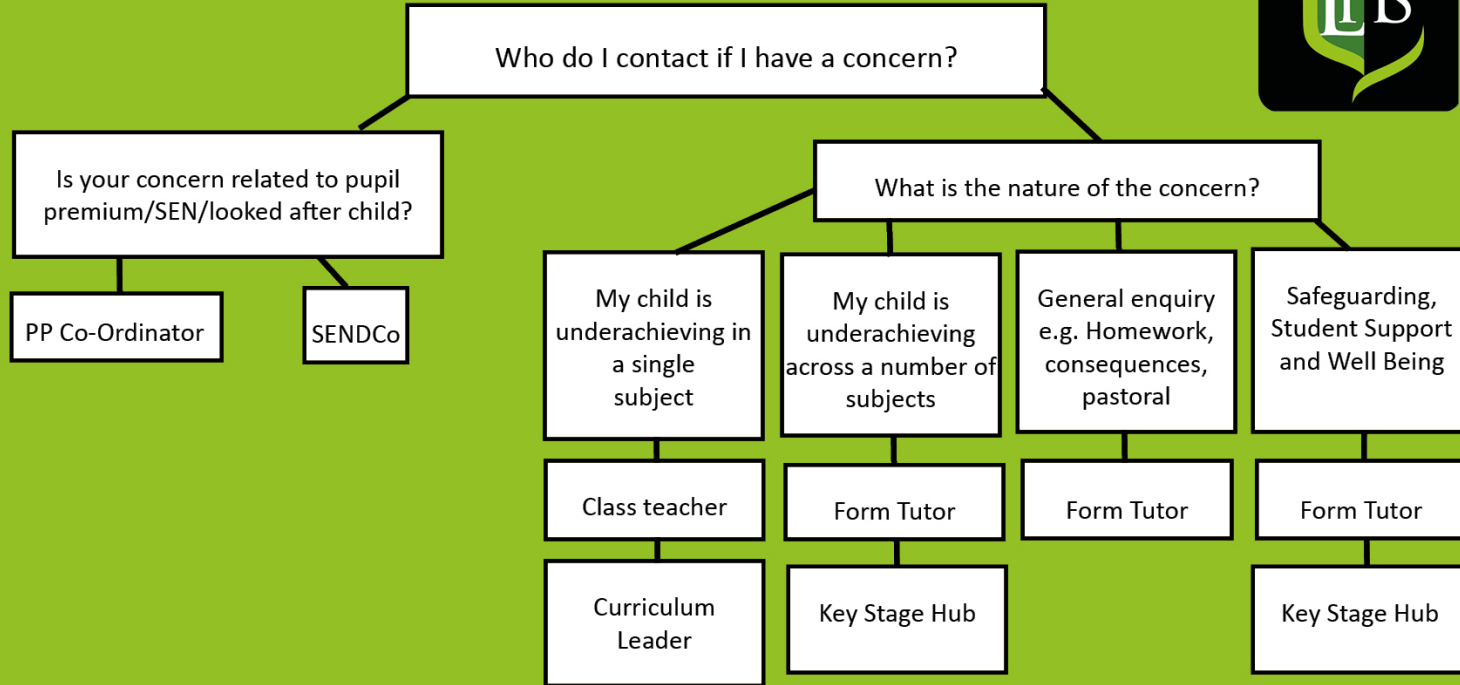
