

Remote Education – Information for families

“Providing remote education: guidance for schools” (DfE, updated 19 August 2024)

This document provides guidance to families on how Lutterworth High School will provide high-quality remote education when it is not possible, or is contrary to government guidance, for some or all students to attend school. For example, a snow day.

Remote education will only ever be considered as a last resort where a decision has already been made that attendance at school is not possible, but students are able to continue learning.

- Work will be published to students on EduLink by 9:30am on the morning of the school closure.
- Work will be provided for all subject areas.
- The work will be meaningful, and tasks will be aligned with current curriculum plans.
- There will be no ‘live lessons’ online. Teachers may make use of the lessons available on the Oak National Academy website [here](#), to provide interactive lessons for their students.
- We may set work using other digital platforms, such as Educake, MyMaths or Ever-Learner.
- Instructions and support materials for independent learning will be provided. How students should complete the work (for example, on paper or online) will be made clear.
- Teachers will be mindful that not all students will have easy access to resources to support learning at home. Where needed, adaptations can be made to tasks to support independent working. For example, where a student does not have their book at home for a particular subject, they can work onto paper or use a computer to complete the task.
- It is recognised that some students with SEND may not be able to access remote education without adult support. We will work collaboratively with families and use our ‘best endeavours’ to put arrangements in place that allow students with SEND to access remote education successfully.
- General school communications will continue via Edulink and email wherever possible. Emergency messages will be posted on the school website.
